Blow Molding Design Guideline Blow Molding Design Guideline 3 Radii / Corners • Material will "freeze" when it comes into contact with the mold, causing it to stretch into corners • If parison is trapped (pinched off) at parting line, it must stretch into the cavity (pre-blowing the parison prior to mold closure helps minimize stretch)

Blow molding (Extrusion Blow Molding) is manufacturing process that forms hollow thermoplastics. A within a split mold cavity, air pressure is applied to a heated plastic material (called a parison) that expands similar to a balloon and is shaped against the walls of the mold cavity.The plastic is then allowed to cool and the part is ejected from the mold cavity.
