Determine the target superheat from the charging calculators or Table RD-2 on pages RD7 and RD8 of the "NON TXV Charging Guide" (See example below, 95°F ODA and 67°F indoor wet-bulb, target superheat 12°F.) Click image to enlarge! ADD refrigerant to DECREASE total superheat. REMOVE refrigerant to INCREASE total superheat.

How to properly charge an air conditioning system

Start charging the gas refrigerant from the refrigerant bottle to the low-pressure side of the HVAC system at connection C by opening the valve A and the refrigerant valve of the charging bottle until the vacuum comes to zero. Now start the compressor as the suction pressure goes above zero.

system service port which is fitted onto the larger of the two refrigerant lines. This line will be one of two which travel out from evaporator core (near the firewall) and will lead to the rear of the compressor.

How to Add Freon in Under 15 Minutes - 2CarPros

Charge in the liquid phase (tank upside down) and add the refrigerant slowly and carefully to ensure you do not flood/slug the compressor with liquid refrigerant. You can do this by watching your manifold sight glass or using a special liquid preventing adapter such as the Imperial 535-C Kwik Charge.

Specs are for total system capacities. Always refer to under hood decal as the primary source for refrigerant and lubricant information.

If charging on the liquid or High side, use only the High side valve on the manifold gauge set. Make sure the Low side valve is closed. After charging, test the system by turning on the engine and running the A/C with both valves closed on the manifold.

CHARGE SYSTEM Shake can well and screw can onto gauge/trigger assembly. Connect the quick connect back on the low-side port. Make sure to always hold the can upright (12 o'clock position) before starting to charge.

Consult the service manual to verify the exact location of the low-side service port. *Most 1994 and older vehicles used R12 as the original refrigerant, if the vehicle being serviced is still using R12, it must be evacuated and retrofitted. Mixing R12 and any

With blue hose attached to the copper pipe attach the yellow hose to your refrigerant canister. Open the valve on the refrigerant canister all the way. For R-22 and 407c do this right side up. For R-410a do this upside down as well as charge upside down.

These units use R-410A refrigerant which operates at 50 to 70% higher pressures than R-22. Use only R-410A approved service equipment. Refrigerant cylinders are painted a “Rose” color to indicate the type of refrigerant and may contain a “dip” tube to allow for charging of liquid refrigerant into the system.

R134a is pumped through the AC system to the evaporator, where cabin air condensates. This condensation allows the cabin air to exchange heat with the refrigerant. It also dehumidifies the air for optimal comfort. If your car is low on R134a, it can't cool as efficiently. And if your car is low on refrigerant, you likely have an AC leak.
