Similarly, in Peace Conference Hints, Mr. Shaw may be challengeable on a score of points—Viscount Grey's responsibility for the war, German atrocities and federalism—but on his main theme, the causes that must inevitably lead to war, he says a far greater number of things that are profoundly and permanently true.
