The "Show All Files" toggle option in Solution Explorer doesn't persist for C++ shared items project. 1. Create a new C++ shared items (\*.vcxitems) project. 2. Add some files to the project directory not in the shared items project. 3. Select the project in Solution Explorer. 4. Click "Show All Files".

## **The "Show All Files" toggle option in Solution Explorer ...**

At the top of the solution explorer panel there should be a button that says "Show All Files" which will allow you to select grayed-out ones that exist but aren't included yet, right click them, and say "Include in Project".

Look for the button you added on the Solution Explorer toolbar. It should be the fourth button from the left. When you click the button, all the files should be filtered out, and you should see All items have been filtered from view. in the Solution Explorer.
